- 1. \$17 per person (small sugar pumpkin and bag of feed for the zoo included). All attendees require an admission ticket (students, chaperones, teachers, etc.).
- 2. A non-refundable \$100 deposit is required. If your school is tax exempt, please submit a tax exempt letter at time of booking. If you are not tax exempt, NJ sales tax will be applied to your total amount owed.
- 3. Your field trip is self-guided and includes access to the Animal Feeding Zoo, Bee Barn, Corn Box, Cornhole, Corn Maze, Corn Tunnel, Giant Checkers, Giant Connect Four, Giant Jenga, Hay Maze, Hi-Striker, Horse Bouncers, Horse Lasso, Horse Swings, Inflatable Corn Maze, Pedal Carts, Pig Race, Pirate Ship, Pumpkin Bowling, Pumpkin Guess Who, Rainbow Tires, Ring Toss, Rubber Duck Racing, Sand Cranes, Spider Web, Tetherball, Tilt-A-Maze, Tire Mountain, Tractor Ride, Tug-O-War, Wooden Train & Wall Ball Games. The following activities are **not** included: Pumpkinville (pumpkin houses), Fun Slide, Paintball, Jumping Pillow, Pumpkin Cannon & Ok Corral.
- 4. Remember to bring payment with you on the day of your field trip. We accept cash or check made out to Happy Day Farm. Payment needs to be made in one lump sum for the whole group. Your \$100 deposit amount will be deducted from your total amount owed.
- 5. We have picnic tables under large tents if you plan to stay for lunch. We encourage you to bring water.
- 6. Readmission is not permitted. Field trip sessions are a 3 hour maximum. Please inform all attendees of this in advance.
- 7. Final headcount is due 5 days before your scheduled event date.
- 8. If it rains on your scheduled date, please call 732-977-3607 to see if we will have to postpone or cancel. Have a backup date arranged with your bus provider, etc. in case this does happen.
- 9. Come prepared for the weather conditions. Please remind your students to dress appropriately (i.e., hats, jackets, gloves). We suggest students wear closed-toed shoes.

### Welcome to your Field Trip at Happy Day Farm! Here is our recommended itinerary:

#### Arrival

Follow signage for the admission booth and online ticketing. A Happy Day Farm employee will help guide you to pay for the balance of your field trip. Afterwards, if you have cameras, you can gather your students for a group photo in front of the iconic 8-foot rocking chair. The rocking chair is located in front of the corn maze.

Next, please assign an adult to a small group of kids. Each chaperone will lead their own small group to the various activities. You should let each chaperone know where and what time your class will reconvene to board the bus.

☐ <b>The Corn Maze</b> Time: 15 min or 45 min depending on your chosen route.		
	a.	Take a photo of the map located outside the corn maze and guide your
		group through. This year's theme celebrates our 10 year farm anniversary.
	b.	You will encounter QR codes and CornText questions in the maze. If you
		know the right answer, it will tell you the right way to turn.

### ☐ **Fairground Activities --** Time: 1 - 2 hours

- a. Groups will be able to explore our fairgrounds which includes agritourism based activities such as Corn Maze, Animal Feeding Zoo, Corn Stalk Tunnel, Pirate Ship, Tractor Ride, Pig Races, Hay Mazes, Pumpkin Bowling, Rubber Duck Racing, Horse Bouncers, Corn Hole, Tire Mountain, Pedal Carts, Sand Cranes, Bean Bag Toss, Tetherball, Spider Web, Observation Bridge, and Horse Swings.
- b. Please note that some attractions are closed to field trips including Pumpkinville, Fun Slide, Paintball, Jumping Pillow, Corn & Pumpkin Cannons & Ok Corral.

## ☐ **Pig Races** -- Time: 10 min

a. The pig race takes place at 11am. Races are located opposite the entrance, next to the pavilion with the red metal roof.

# ☐ Tractor Ride & Pumpkin Picking -- Time: 30 min

- a. Hop on a tractor and enjoy a fun-filled ride to our 15-acre pumpkin patch. Each paid guest is entitled to a small sugar pumpkin to take home as their very own souvenir of their visit.
- b. Have your bus pick your group up directly from the pumpkin patch.

**Note:** if your school plans to stay for lunch, we have picnic tables located under the pavilion and under the white tent.
